

RESPONSE OF SCHOOL PRINCIPALS AT ST. FABIAN AND OUR LADY OF SORROWS TO VICARIATE PEI QUESTIONS:

Are there collaborative efforts that could be undertaken between Our Lady of Sorrows and St. Fabian schools?

- **Inservices have been given at both parishes for the teaching staffs. Future planning could include speakers/activities for the parents and students at both schools.**

- **MEAP testing sites were available on different Saturdays to accomodate students at both schools.**

- **A foreign language teacher was shared by the two schools. In the future, a situation like this could occur again in which both schools could work together.**

- **The principals at both schools meet regularly to discuss ways they can collaborate for the advancement of the schools. The counselors meet as well to assess varying strategies and techniques for the betterment of the students.**

- **Both schools could investigate purchasing materials collaboratively.**

- **Materials such as programs, videos, dvd's, etc. could be shared between the two schools.**

What efforts could be made at the vicariate level to financially support these schools?

- **Parishes without schools could encourage their parishioners to send their children to Our Lady of Sorrows or St. Fabian. In return, the parishes could contribute to the upkeep of the schools and know that their children would be a priority in being accepted to the schools.**
