Sbj: Volleyball Volunteer Schedule

Attached to this memo is the volunteer schedule for the 2007 CYO Volleyball season. Here's a list of important items for you to remember:

- 1) If you can't work on your scheduled date, it is **your** responsibility to contact another parent from your child's team and trade assignments with them. Then contact your parent representative and tell her about the change.
- 2) If you fail to attend during your assigned time, we will contact you and reschedule you for a future home game.
- 3) After the meeting, I realized that St. Fabian must provide only one line judge per game, so I have adjusted the schedule accordingly.
- 4) The volunteer program is intended for our parents, so please do not ask one of your older children to work for you. Again, if you are unable to work as scheduled, please trade with another parent from your child's team.
- 5) When you arrive at the school, the person taking admissions will have a copy of the master volunteer schedule. Please initial that sheet next to your name to indicate that you worked the games as scheduled. When you sign in, your admission fee will be waived for that day. **Volunteering to help = Free admission!**
- 6) As shown on the schedule, the first shift volunteers at each game will also help set up the gym, starting one hour before the first game. Admissions volunteers will start taking admissions at that same time, therefore they shouldn't help with setup. That person should remain at the admissions desk until the second shift admissions person arrives.
- 7) As shown on the schedule, the second shift volunteers at each game will also help clean up the gym.

### **Definition of volunteer positions:**

**Admissions:** - At the front desk, collect admission fee from fans, and sign-in volunteers. Admissions person doesn't need to assist with setup. A cash box, admissions prices and volunteer schedule will be provided for you.

**Line Judge:** - On the court during the game, assisting the referee with in/out calls. The referee will provide instructions.

**Scoreboard:** - At the scorer's table, running the scoreboard. Instructions will be provided.

**Score Book:** - At the scorer's table, writing the score in the score book. The coach will provide instructions.

Thank you for assisting us with our volleyball program this year. Please work with me to make this volunteer plan successful, and as always, feel free to contact me if you have any suggestions for improving our program.
