Since March is National Reading Month, we will be doing some activities here at St. Fabian to celebrate! The purpose of this month is to motivate all school children to enjoy reading and take time out every day and read. Our STF theme this year is **"READING IS AN ADVENTURE"**.

All classrooms will have a box in their rooms where children can donate a new or slightly used book for charity. We will also have a book mark contest and will choose one winner from PreK-2, 3-5, and middle school. The book marks are due by March 15<sup>th</sup>.

Each child in the school will get a map of the United States and they can see how far they can travel by reading, with every 10 minutes of reading (or being read to) will qualify them to color in one state. The maps will be due at the end of the month for a small classroom prize.

We will also have some school wide activities as follows:

- **Tuesday March 5<sup>th</sup> Flashlight Tuesday** Students can dress in their favorite pjs and bring a flashlight to school. Teachers will pick a time that their class will get cozy and just read!
- **Wednesday March 13<sup>th</sup> Favorite Character Dress Up Day** Students can dress as their favorite book character today.

This is where the teacher stands out in the hall with the book she is going to read and the children are free to go to any classroom and listen to the story. Bookmarks due today.
- **Friday, March 29<sup>th</sup> Elementary Book Walk** Also, last day for book collection.

Along with these fun activities, individual classrooms will be setting aside a time for D.E.A.R (Drop Everything And Read) each day, and Mystery Readers throughout the month.
