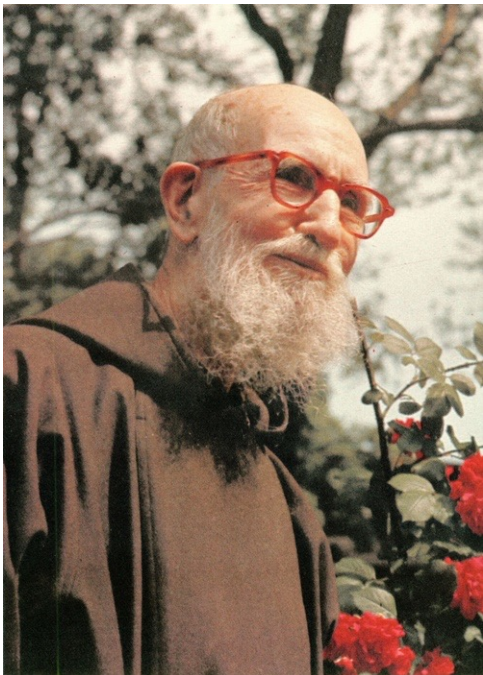


## Beatification Mass for Fr. Solanus Casey NEW DETAILS



Fr. Solanus Casey was a humble Capuchin Friar who was credited with miraculous cures and valued for his wise and compassionate counsel. He spent his life in the service of people. Because of his holiness, Pope John Paul II declared him Venerable in 1995. Pope Francis has announced that Fr. Solanus will be Beatified on November 18, 4 p.m., at Ford Field in Detroit. People in Detroit already think of him as “Detroit’s Saint.”

- Doors open at 2pm, Vigil Mass starts at 4pm.
- Food may not be brought in to Ford Field, and concessions will be restricted.
- Parishioners of all groups and ages are invited to represent St. Fabian.
- Pack patience, water, and a battery pack (for your smartphone, tablet, etc).

Attending the Beatification at Ford Field on November 18:

### Option 1: No Transportation Provided

- St. Fabian requested 200 event tickets, but these are not guaranteed yet.
- These are intended for St. Fabian parishioners.
- We need you to contact the office with the names for every individual ticket.
- Requesting a ticket does not guarantee an event ticket will be available.

### Option 2: Transportation Provided, Guaranteed Main Floor Tickets

- St. Fabian is offering bus transportation for 200 passengers.
- This includes special seats on the main floor, behind the priests.
- Cost to parish is about \$45/passenger
- We are selling tickets for a minimum donation of \$25 each, on a first paid basis. Checks made payable to “St. Fabian” Solanus in the memo.
- One bus will be equipped with a handicapped lift.
- Depending on interest, we may reserve the right to refuse non-parishioners.
