***Please note, pending AOD and CDC guidelines, this is subject to change. This is an evolving document. ***

While at Home:

- Parents/guardians are required to take child's temperature *every* morning and fill out screening in APP. More information to be provided.
- It is strongly encouraged that each student has a minimum of 2-3 masks, with their first and last name labeled on it, and that students practice safe wearing of masks at home for extended times.
- Cloth masks should be washed daily.
- Students with a temperature of 100.4 or greater should stay home and consider testing for Covid-19.
- Any positive test results must be reported immediately to school office.

Screening:

- All staff who enter the building will be screened and must wear mask.
- Family members (parents/guardians) or other non-staff adults are not allowed in the school building except under extenuating circumstances determined by school officials.

Arrival to School:

- School grades K-8 will start at 7:55 AM; Preschool will start at 8:10 AM.
- Students will arrive wearing masks and enter the building.
- Pre-school will enter at separate doors, K-4 through the doors by the social hall, and 5-8 through the main lobby doors.
- Students will practice social distancing as they wait to enter the building if early.

School Day Protocols:

✓ Masks:

- Staff will wear masks when in classrooms and hallways.
- All students must wear masks when traveling outside the classroom.
- Students in grades Preschool-5 are not required, but may choose to wear masks, in their classrooms unless (1) students do not remain with their cohort class throughout the school day and (2) come into close contact with students in another class.
- All students in grades 6-8 will wear masks except during meals.

✓ Hygiene:

- Proper hand hygiene techniques (for coughing/sneezing) will be reviewed with staff and students.
- All classrooms will have hand sanitizer and disinfectant available.
- Bathrooms will not exceed the number of stalls vs. the number of students.
- Proper handwashing will be maintained.
- Water fountains will be not be available for use.
- Students are asked to bring water bottle labeled with name.
- Students can use water filling stations throughout the day.

✓ Classroom Procedures:

- The entire school/church have been treated with Microshield for added protection.
- Desks will be wiped down periodically throughout the day as well as at the end of each day.
- Teachers will take periodic breaks for students to wash hands.
- Hand sanitizer will be in each classroom. Students will be required to sanitize hands upon entry.
- Middle school students will move from room to room and gather books from their locker. Students will be staggered and kept as socially distanced in the hallway as possible.
- Individual student locker assignments will be spaced out.
- Desks will be wiped down before any “new” child sits at desk.

✓ Specials Classes:

- Regular school uniforms will be worn every day, including days when students are in physical education classes.
- Students will walk from their classroom to their special class, wearing a mask and do the same to return to the remainder of their class schedule.
- Students will wear masks during music class.

✓ Lunch/Recess:

- Lunch will take place in the classroom. Subject to change.
- If students order lunch, lunch will be delivered to the classroom.
- Students will sanitize/wash hands before and after lunch.
- Students will have designated areas on the playground and socially distance.
- Playground equipment and gym equipment has been treated by Microshield for an added layer of protection.

✓ Mass:

- Students will participate in mass weekly.
- Still working on a safe plan.

✓ Quarantine Area:

- Staff exhibiting signs of Covid-19 will be sent home immediately to be tested.
- Student exhibiting signs of Covid-19 will be placed in the quarantine area(s) provided in the school office. Students will be sent home, tested, and will be permitted to return to school with a doctor’s note verifying a negative test result.
