St. Fabian Parent Involvement Program (PIP) 2022-2023 School Year

What is PIP?

The PIP (Parent Involvement Program) at St. Fabian Catholic School gives our families the opportunity to participate and interact with their children and serve a greater role in the St. Fabian school community. This volunteerism shows that *"We are dedicated to the enrichment of the whole child through academic excellence, spiritual development and service to our community."* (STF Mission Statement)

How many hours does each family need?

K-8th grade families must volunteer **20 hours** by May 31 (*or prior to 8th grade graduation if you have an 8th grader; graduating 8th graders must be paid/or hours completed in full before graduation.*)

Where do I find PIP opportunities?

- Falcon Flyer
- Emails from the school office
- Recess Duty (daily)
- PTG Event donations (1 PIP hour per \$25 spent)

How do I log my hours?

Each family must use the FACTS SIS to log all hours. (Instructions [HERE](#).)

What happens if I don't volunteer?

Families who do not complete the required PIP hours will be billed **\$25.00** for every hour they are short. If you are short 10 hours, you will be billed \$250; short 20 hours you will be billed \$500. Families will be billed on June 1st. Final student records will not be released until all fees are paid.

What happens next?

- Your account will be reviewed at the end of each trimester, and you will receive notification as to how many hours you have completed to date. On May 31st, a final review of the hours completed will occur and if less than 20 hours have been worked, your FACTS account will be charged.
- It is advised that you stay current with your tracking of service hours.
- Each event must be recorded separately.
